

**Double Four Patch**  
**6" finished**  
**3 fabrics**

**Cutting:**

Light:

4 squares @ 2"

Medium:

2 squares @ 2"

1 square @ 3 1/2"

Dark:

2 squares @ 2"

1 square @ 3 1/2"

**Piecing:**


**4-Patch Units:**

Sew a dark and a light 2" square together. Press to the dark.

Sew a medium and light 2" square together. Press to the medium.





Sew these units together to form a chain with the light squares.

Make 2.



Following the block diagram above, sew these 4 patch units and the 3 1/2" squares into 2 rows. Press to the 3 1/2" square. Sew the rows together. Press to one side, or, if you are making several, swirl the center seam, loosening threads at center intersecting seams. Press counter-clockwise (as viewed from right side.)

This is an easy block but set together you can make many, many layouts. It can also be a leader/ender project or stash busting project. These samples are set 10 x 10.



Just be sure to have good contrast between your fabrics. Enjoy, Grace
