



Grecian Square
12" block
2 Fabrics

Cutting:

Dark Purple:

2 squares @ 4 7/8"

1 square @ 4 1/2"

4 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Light Lavender:

2 squares @ 4 7/8"

4 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Piecing:

Half-Square Triangle Units:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Light Lavender 4 7/8" squares.

Layer right sides together with the Dark Purple 4 7/8" squares.

Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line.

Press toward the Dark Purple. You have 4 HST units.



Strip unit:

Layer the Dark Purple and Light Lavender rectangles right sides together. Stitch together along the long side. Press toward the Dark Purple. You have 4 strip units.



Following the block diagram above, lay out these units and the remaining Dark Purple square into three rows.

Sew the units into rows. Press rows 1 & 3 toward the center; press row 2 away from the center.

Sew the rows together.

Try this on point with an alternate Churn Dash block.

It would also look good as a scrap quilt with each block a different color, keeping the same background.
