

**Jacob's Ladder**  
**12" block**  
**2 colors**

**Cutting:**

**Beige:**

10 squares @ 2 1/2"  
2 squares @ 4 7/8" cut once diagonally

**Burgundy:**

10 squares @ 2 1/2"  
2 squares @ 4 7/8" cut once diagonally

**Piecing:**

**Four Patch Units:**

From the Beige and Burgundy 2 1/2" squares, sew 5 four-patch units.






**Triangle Square Units:**

From the Beige and Burgundy half-square triangles, sew 4 triangle-square units. Press to the burgundy.



Following the block diagram above, lay out the four-patch units and triangle units into three rows. Sew the rows. Press the rows in opposite directions. Sew the rows together.

You can get many different quilts with different rotations of these blocks.
