



Spinner  
12" block  
3 Fabrics

**Cutting:**

**Cream:**

4 squares @  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Blue:**

2 squares @  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut once diagonally

**Dark Rose:**

4 squares @  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut once diagonally

**Piecing:**

**Unit 1:** Sew Dark Rose  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " HST triangles to the sides of the  $3\frac{1}{3}$ " Cream squares to make a HST triangle. Press toward the Dark Rose. Make 4.



**Unit 2:** Sew a Blue  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " HST to Unit 1. Press toward the Blue triangle. Make 4.



Following the block diagram above, layout these units as a four-patch, rotating each on a quarter turn. Sew into two rows. Sew the rows together.

This is an easy block but really changes when you switch the Rose & Cream. Also try experimenting with and without sashing.
