



**Two By Two**  
**6" block**  
**2 Fabrics**

**Cutting:**

**Teal:**

4 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"

**Cream:**

4 rectangles @ 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

**Piecing: Quarter Block Units**

Sew a **Teal** rectangle to a **Cream** rectangle along the long side.

Press toward the **Teal**.

Make 4.



Following the block diagram above, lay out the 4 quarter block units into 2 rows.

Sew the 2 rows. Then, sew the rows together. Be careful in the placement/direction of the units.

You can make a quick baby quilt with this block.

With 36 blocks, set 6 x 6, you need a 1/2 yard total of background and only 14" of printed fabric for each block.

Use up all those leftover strips from your jelly rolls.

Enjoy you block.
