



Waterwheel
12" block
3 colors

Cutting:

White:

8 squares @ 2 1/2"
 2 squares @ 4 7/8"

Pink:

1 square @ 4 1/2"
 2 squares @ 4 7/8"

Blue:

8 squares @ 2 1/2"

Piecing:

Four Path Units:

From the Blue and White 2 1/2" squares, sew 4 four-patch units.



Triangle Square Units:

Layer the Pink and White 4 7/8" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white square. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line, press to the pink. You will have 4 triangle-square units.



Following the block diagram above, lay out the four-patch units, the triangle-square units and the pink 4 1/2" square into 3 rows. Sew into rows; press rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together.

Adding sashing makes a big difference in the look of this quilt.
