

**Weathervane**  
**12" Block**  
**3 Fabrics**

**Cutting:**

**Cream:**

4 squares @ 2 1/2"  
 8 squares @ 2 7/8" cut once diagonally

**Peach:**

4 squares @ 2 1/2"  
 1 square @ 4 1/2"

**Purple:**

4 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"  
 4 squares @ 2 7/8" cut once diagonally  
 1 square @ 5 1/4" cut twice diagonally

**Piecing:**

**Flying Geese Units:**

Sew the background half-square triangles to the short sides of the purple quarter-square triangles. Make 4.  
 Following the block diagram, sew a purple rectangle to each flying geese unit.



**Half-square Triangle Units:**

Sew the background and purple half-square triangles together to make 8 HST units.





**Corner units:**

Sew the HST triangle units, the cream 2 1/2" squares and the peach 2 1/2" squares into four-patch units for the corners.



Following the block diagram above, lay out all these units and the remaining peach square into three rows. Sew the units into rows. Sew the rows together.

Set together with or without plain sashing, you get an interesting secondary design.
