



Getting Ready for Christmas

Supply lists



Homer:

Christmas Present Potholder

Supplies:

Green. At least one 2.5 inch strip.
Red, At least a 3 inch strip.
Background 1/2 yard is more than enough.
Insul-Bright batting, enough for two layers.
12 x 24 inch piece will work.
4.5 inch piece of ribbon (optional)
if you want your pot holder to hang.)
Cotton thread in a color to match your fabrics,
not polyester

Central Peninsula:

Scandinavian Fabric Stars

Cutting:

Out of green:

- 2 2.5 inch squares
- 2 1.5 inch x 3 inch strips
- 1 1.5 inch x 5.5 inch strip

Out of holly (red) fabric:

- 2 2 inch x 3 inch
- 2 3 inch x 3 inch

Out of Linen:

- 2 1.5 inch x 2.5 inch strips
- 1 4.5 inch x 2.5 inch strip
- 2 1.5 inch x 7.5 inch strip (border)
- 2 1.5 inch x 8.5 inch strip (border)

These folded fabric stars are good for Christmas Ornaments, to tie on a package or use as a gift.

Fabric: 4 fabrics that look good together. Use a variation of print/sizes/stripes/plaids/solids.

Cutting:

From each fabric, cut 1 12 inch x 3 ¼ rectangle

Press strips like double fold bias tape (in half, then fold the edges in to the center and iron again)

Seward:

Card Holder Pouch

Supply list:

- 1 - fat quarter (will make 2) OR 1 piece of fabric 12 inch x 18 inch
- 1 - package Wide Bias Tape – Contrasting or Complementary to your fabric



Optional:

- 1 - 5 inch square of Contrasting or Complementary fabric for pocket
